## **GENERAL CODE OF BEHAVIOUR**

As a person required to comply with the Member Protection Policy, you must meet the following requirements in regard to your conduct during any activity or event held by or under the auspices of Netball NSW, an affiliated Association or an affiliated Club.

- 1. Be ethical, fair and honest in all dealings with other people and Netball NSW.
- 2. Treat all persons with respect and courtesy and have proper regard for their dignity, rights and obligations.
- 3. Always place the safety and welfare of children above other considerations.
- 4. Comply with Netball NSW's constitution, rules and policies including this Member Protection Policy.
- 5. Operate within the rules and spirit of the sport.
- 6. Comply with all relevant Australian laws (Federal and State), particularly anti-discrimination and child protection laws.
- 7. Be responsible and accountable for your conduct.
- 8. Abide by the relevant Netball NSW Role-Specific Codes of Behaviour.

Failure to comply with the Code of Behaviour will result in appropriate action being taken in accordance with the Member Protection Policy.
